How to show visitors counter using the CG editor?

With the new CG editor you can create your own graphics template by mixing images, videos and text fields.

Text fields can be made dynamic, which means that you can change these texts for each item in the playlist.

Here we will show you an example of how to make a template to show the audience count during the game.



1. New template will be added and shown in the right panel.
2. Give the template a name so you easily can find it later when you will add it to a playlist.
3. Open CG Editor.



4. An open image dialog will be shown where you can select the image file you want to add.
5. Image will be placed on the canvas area and you can now resize and position the image with the image settings in the ribbon area.
6. Add logotype using the same button. Resize image using the red borders with the mouse and move it to the desired place.



7. You can also add effects like blur and shadow to the text fields.



8. This name will be the label for the text field shown in the editor later on in the playlist.
8. Make the template look something like this:



9. Select the template you want to use in the Template drop-down.
